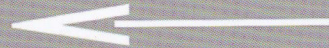

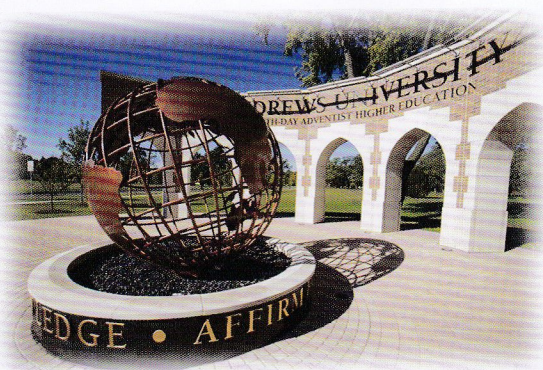

2+2 Degree Programmes

Since 2016, Andrews University launched a 2+2 degree programme which allows students to study 2 years in Hong Kong plus 2 years in the United States to complete a bachelor degree. Students registered in this programme are eligible for a 50% tuition discount while studying at Andrews U.S. campus.

Tuition (estimated based on 2018 - 2019) :

Bachelor of Technology (Aviation Flight)

The Aviation Department of Andrews University offers seven different degrees including a Bachelor of Technology in two main areas of concentration: Aviation Flight and Aviation Maintenance. The flight training programme prepares students for Private through Airline Transport Pilot Licenses, encompassing the instrument and multi-engine ratings. In addition, the Department offers specialized mission aviation training. The Aircraft Maintenance Technician programme is a licensed 147 school, leading to the Aircraft Maintenance Technician License with Airframe and Powerplant ratings. The Department offers a well-rounded Christian education and along with FAA certifications.

Recognition

The Aviation Department of Andrews University is fully accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC), the Accrediting Association of Seventh-day Adventist (AAA) and the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). Part 141 flight training that leads to the Letter of Authorization that allows Airline Transport Pilots (ATP) to get their ATP with 1,000 hours, rather than 1,500. The Aircraft Maintenance Technician School is Part 147.



Course Structure

The Aviation Flight programme is typically a 4-year full time programme. It consists of a total of 124 semester credits. A student must complete a minimum of 60 credits in Major area, 20-23 credits of the undergraduate electives, and 41-44 credits of the general education programme.

Graduation Requirements

Students must maintain minimum GPA of 2.5 in all aviation coursework and 2.25 cumulative overall.

A Private Pilot Certificate, Instrument Rating, and a Commercial Pilot Certificate with Single and Multi-Engine Ratings and Certified Flight Instructor and Air Transport Pilot written exam are required for graduation.

Admission Requirements

- 1). HKDSE 33222 or equivalent.
- 2) Must be accepted by Andrews University before admission to the Flight programme.
 - IBT (TOEFL) score of 80 or IELTS 6.5, or equivalent.
 - 1st Class FAA medical with Student Pilot Certificate prior to entry into the Flight programme.
 - For ALL NON-U.S. CITIZENS, an additional government application to the Transportation Security Administration (TSA), which includes an FBI background check, is required for each flight class. Students must receive department authorization before starting the TSA application process.
TSA AUTHORIZATION IS REQUIRED BEFORE ANY FLIGHT CLASSES CAN BE STARTED.

Important Notes

- In addition to tuition, flight lab fees apply to all flight training courses (see Department of Aviation Charges on www.andrews.edu).
- Intake for Flight programme is only in the Fall semester.

? WHY AVIATION AT ANDREWS

- Andrews University's Aviation programme is accredited by the U.S. Department of Transportation's Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), and the aircraft are professionally maintained by Andrews' own FAA-certified mechanics.
- Andrews has its own Airpark and it's just one mile from campus. Here, students will be able to work on aircraft like a Cessna 150, T-33, Lear 24 and also an newest addition, a Mitsubishi MU2.
- The Aviation Department of Andrews University operates a modern fleet of single-engine aircraft for training courses. Andrews even has a flight simulation building that has caught the attention of major aviation magazines.
- Along with small class sizes, Andrews offers a Bachelor of Technology in Aviation. Consider a dual emphasis in both flight and maintenance to improve students' skillsets.
- Improve job marketability in a competitive field. Earn a number of certifications to go with the degree like Aircraft Maintenance Technician, Commercial Pilot and more.
