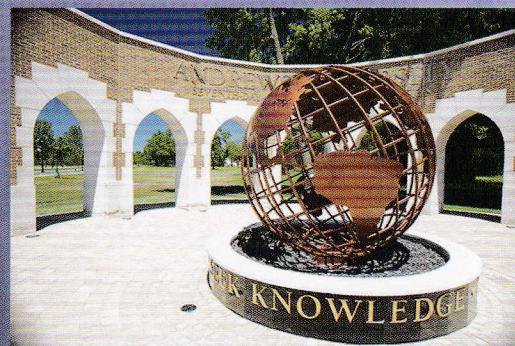

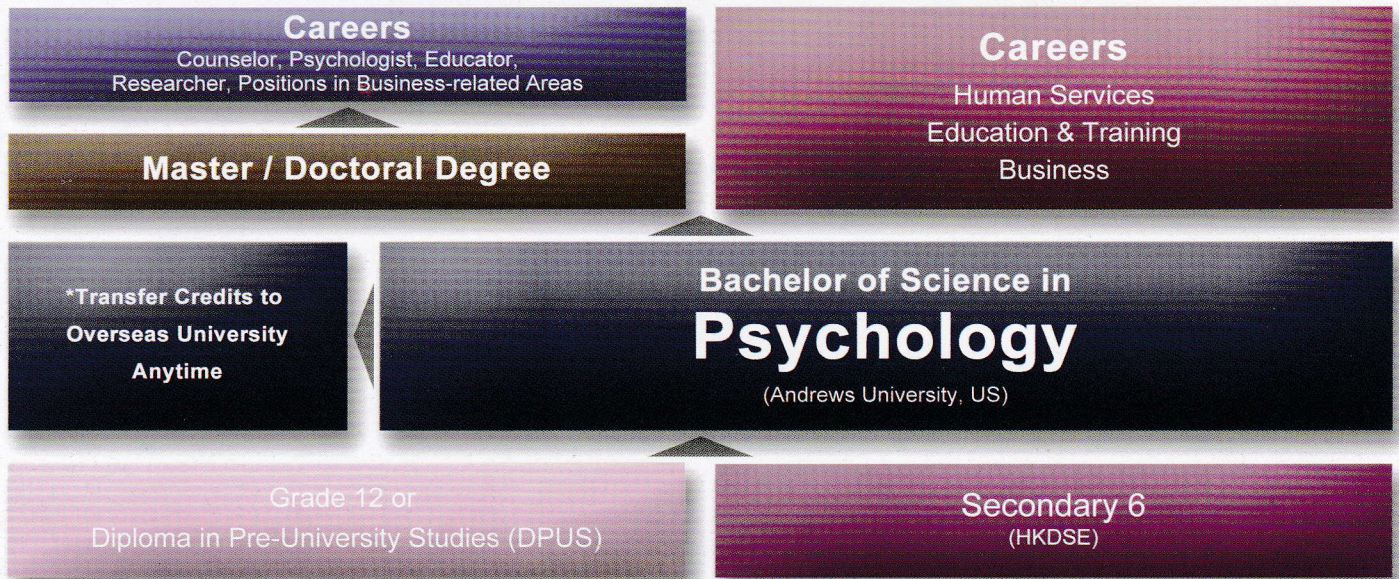

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. Hong Kong Diploma in Secondary Education (HKDSE)

Level 3 in English and Chinese Language

Level 2 in Mathematics and Liberal Studies

Level 2 in an Elective subject

2. 12-year High School Programme Graduate

A minimum High school GPA of 2.50 overall and ACT/SAT composit scores at the 50th percentile (currently, these scores are 20 ACT and 940-970 [Verbal & Math] SAT; but are subject to adjustment annually) are required for admission

3. Approved Pre-university Course

Graduating GPA of 2.50

Students who do NOT meet the minimum requirements may be admitted PROVISIONALLY on a case by case basis as determined by Andrews University.

Scholarship

- Pre-registration Scholarship, HK\$10,000
- Academic Performance Scholarship up to HK\$20,000 annually

Government Loan

Eligible for Hong Kong Government's Non-Means Tested Loan.
